

FLOWER GUILD POLICY

There has been a growing amount of confusion regarding flowers given in thanksgiving and memorial, and in celebration of birthdays or anniversaries. In the past we have tried to accommodate those who do not want to share offerings with others on the same week. However, we are finding it increasingly difficult to please everyone. Therefore a consistent policy has been put in place so as to not upset or offend anyone. The policies are as follows:

1. The Flower Guild cannot guarantee that a family will not be sharing the flowers with another family on the same week. The only time that this would not apply is if there are wedding flowers left on request.
2. The church calendar specifies the use of specific colored flowers for various seasons and certain feast days. The Flower Guild is obligated to observe these colors in the altar arrangements.

To arrange for flowers you may either contact the church office (723-8032), you may drop your flower request in the offering plate, or you may mail in your request. Please specify the Sunday you'd like the flowers displayed, along with the reason for your donation (i.e. in memory of, in thanksgiving for, etc.). If you'd like what is printed in the bulletin to be worded in a specific way, please include this with your donation. The bulletin deadline is Tuesday by noon.
