

Spiritual Gifts in Corinth

Paul mentions 16 gifts in First Corinthians repeating 4 in Second Corinthians. In chapter 12:8-11, he identifies nine: wisdom, knowledge, faith, gifts of healing, miracles, prophecy, discernment, tongues, interpretation of tongues, and adds administration, teaching, apostleship and helping in verse 28. The emphasis here is using gifts to clarify and keep clear the message and presence of Jesus Christ—rather than defining each gift.
