

Isaiah 3:1-15 - Anarchy in Jerusalem - without leaders society breaks down

- Without leaders society breaks down
- Support and staff, everything which supports life, including food and drink (economic resources)
- Offices necessary for the continuity and stability of the state
- The inexperienced and naive will rule
- Civil unrest will become open violence

3:8-12 - a commentary on vs. 1-7; Judah's brazen sinfulness and rejection of God's leadership has ruined the people

3:13-15 - God will judge the corrupt judges (Elders) the administrators of justice and Princes - royal appointees

3:16—4:1 - The humiliation of Jerusalem's women

4:2-6 - Jerusalem's restoration

- Branch - the righteous remnant
- Fruit of the land - a return to paradise
- Recorded for life
- Smoke and flaming fire - the signs of God's presence among his people at the Exodus

5:1-7 - The Song of The Vineyard

5:8-24 - Six reproaches
