

## OUTLINE: Isaiah Chapters 5-9

5:8-24 — reproaches - verses 8, 11, 18, 20, 21, 22, 10:1-4, 5:24-30 – a judgement

6:1-13 — the call of Isaiah - God's appearance is described in the setting of the Jerusalem temple (Ezekiel 1:4-2:1)

6:6-8 — cleansed by God's forgiving act Isaiah may now speak for God

6:9-12 — compare Jeremiah's call Chapter 1

7:1 - 8:15 — Isaiah and the Syro-Ephraimite War

1:10-17 — the sign of Immanuel - God is with us

7:18-25 — four threats - on that day

8:1-4 — the sign of Maher-shalal-hash-baz

8:5-10 — oracle of Shiloah and the Euphrates

8:11-22 — testimony and teaching

9:2-7 — the messianic king - may have referred to a Judean king in the line of David - also 11:1-9

9:8 - 10:4 — Ephraim's judgement and object lesson for Judah
