

Isaiah 23 – oracle of Tyre and Sidon

23:5-11 – fallen Tyre's commercial empire; Ezekiel 26,27,28

24 - 27 – The Isaiah Apocalypse – transition between traditional prophetic and apocalyptic writings – universal judgment, eschatological banquet, heavenly signs

24:1-6 – universal judgment

24:7-16 – deliverance after destruction

24:16b-23 – universal judgment

25:1-5 – psalm of thanksgiving

25:6-10a – third eschatological section

25:10b-12 – oracle of doom

26:1-6 – song of victory

26:7-19 – apocalyptic psalm

26:10-14 – in good or bad times the wicked fail to note God's guiding hand but God and the righteous will ultimately defeat them

26:16-19 – without God, the people were in agony and helpless before their oppressors. Though as dead they will be raised up by God whose radiant dew will illumine the gloom of despair

26:20 - 27:1 – Fourth eschatological section

27:2-11 – Fourth apocalyptic poem of deliverance

27:7-13 – Judah will be blessed after all idolatry is removed; concluding oracle of doom and triumph
